Tournament Activities

Seniors (over 65) can hit from the Gold Tee Box

Double Bogey Max – If your team misses on their bogey attempt, pick-up your ball and take a Double Bogey (2 strokes over par).

Putting Contest (at putting green)

Players participating will come to the putting green as they round the turn from hole #9 to hole #10. Players starting at hole #10 should do the Putting Contest before starting play. Players will provide the BDASC Volunteer with their ticket and putt from either one or both of two holes they want to putt for in the contest. **Only one putt per hole**. One hole will be putting for a chance to split the pot 50/50 (if more than one winner, their 50% is divided between the winners) and the other hole will be putting for a chance to win a dozen TaylorMade TP5 golf balls. Players are to use their own ball. Winners/prizes will be given out at the Awards Reception.

Hole #3 - Donation Hole - Charity Golf International, Long Drive Champion Kyle Blakely

Use our Professional Long Driver Kyle Blakely's 400-yard drive on this long par 4. This is BDASC's donation hole and we look for your support again on this hole.

Hole #11 - Beat the Pro with Perry Parker

Teams will have the opportunity to try and Perry's Tee Shot as part of the Tournament. Each Player will take their own Tee Shot. For a donation \$10, Players can see if they can beat Perry's Tee Shot and the chance to win the hole prize. If more than 1 Player beats Perry's Tee Shot, their names will go into a pool that will be drawn at the Awards Reception. If a team donates \$40, the team can use Perry's Tee shot. If a Team donates \$100, they can take an automatic Birdie. Players must decide if they will play before Perry takes his Tee Shot.

Hole #15 – Closest to the Pin

Both men and women compete for the Closet to the Pin Prize. Marker will be on the green. Players cannot use a Mulligan or Red Tee.

Hole # 17 - Men and Women Longest Drive

Ball must be in the fairway. Men's and Women's markers will be in the fairway. Players cannot use a Mulligan or Red Tee and Senior men must hit from the White Tee Box to be included in the Long Drive competition.

Hole #1- Spin2Win Tee Shot:

All players must spin the wheel to determine what and how they will hit their tee shot. If a player does not like their spin, they can pay \$5.00 to spin again. If a player does not like his or her second spin or does not want to participate, they must pay \$10.00 to opt out of the Spin2Win Tee Shot. Types of Tee Shots include; Move up or back a tee, Hit with a longer or shorter club, Hit opposite hand, Hit with a novelty golf ball, Tee off in the fairway from the 150 yard marker, Drop your ball on the green designated location and putt for an eagle, Use Sue's Tee Shot.

Hole #18 - Charity Guns Golf Competition

Shoot your ball out of an AR-15 rifle to the target. *Closest to the target wins*. Players are to provide their own ball.

<u>Hole #2 and #15 – Poker Play Challenge Holes: (cash winner)</u>

Poker Play Challenge - \$5.00 per player purchased at registration. Poker Card and 3 playing cards are provided at registration. Make your Tee Shot on the Green and pick (2) cards from our volunteers. Don't make the green, you still pick a card. The volunteers will mark your Poker Card with the playing card(s) you picked with their initials in the box on your Poker Card. At the end of the tournament, pick your best five playing cards to make your poker hand. Fill out the Poker Card as indicated with your best poker hand and give to Sue/or put in the black box at the podium at the beginning of the Awards Ceremony. The T-Off members will signify the winning hand! Proceeds are split 50/50 with the winner and HSC. Good Luck!!!

String Saves (Cannot be used on Prize Holes)

Purchase 5' of string for \$20 **(only 1 per team)**. String Saves can be used for (Moving a ball out of a hazard, bunker, or from OOB into play or from rough to fairway, or on the green for a continuation of a missed putt (Decision to use string must be made before the next golfer putts). Measure the length of string to be used from where your ball lies to the new location, cut off that amount and discard. Distance must be within the amount of string remaining.

Hole #9 – 3 Flag Pins:

No matter where you land on the green, you will have 3 Flag Pin options available to you to make your put a little easier.

Team Prizes:

1st Place team- (each player) Beer Stine, 1st place, \$100.00 cash, BDASC Par Swag

2nd Place team- (each player) Beer Glass, 2nd place, 1 Round of Golf @ the Preserve, TaylorMade TP5 Balls, BDASC Swag

All other hole and team prizes will be announced and awarded at the reception®

<u>Beverages and Beverage Carts:</u> (no charge) Ice Chest and snacks will be available at Putting Green with water, soda and Gatorade (no beer is allowed in un-supervised ice chests) and beverage carts with the same drinks & *beer included* will be cruising up and down the front and back nine throughout the tournament. **Note – only 3 beers/golfer can be given at a time.**
